

## AMA Alpha Postal Contest

### Official Rules

- All participants must be current AMA members under the age of 19 years old. Note that these ages can access a free membership at <http://www.modelaircraft.org/membership/youth.aspx>
- Only the AMA Alpha can be used in the competition.
- Rubber motors only, with no limit on size or mass. **Motors must be viewable on the model when the flight concludes.**
- Airplane may be modified, but only with kit materials and wingspan **may not exceed 48cm.**
- All official submissions must be accompanied by YouTube video and AMA membership number.
- All official flights must be flown indoors, maximum acceptable ceiling height is 30'.
- Prior to making official flight video, contestants may assemble and trim (test) fly the AMA Alpha to achieve maximum time aloft.
- **The contestant may work with another associate, but must be viewed measuring the wingspan, using the winder, and launching the model during the official flight video. Motors must be viewable on the model when the flight concludes.**
- Though minor modifications are encouraged, any changes must be documented and submitted with the video for review.

**\*AMA officials reserve the right to review all videos for compliance, and consider any variations due to a contestant's disability.**
